Do The Loving Thing

I had been the Pastor at Shearer Hills Baptist Church in San Antonio for about six months when I walked past a Sunday School class of some of our Senior Adult Ladies. I had not been at the church long enough to know this, but some of the very finest people I have ever known were a part of that group. That day they wanted to let the new pastor know that I was lacking in something that was very important to them. They said, "Dr. Loftis, our last Pastor was a hugger, you don't seem to be a hugger, and we miss that." They were right, the truth is I was not much of a hugger at the time. But I realized it was important to them and over time I got better.

- The church will sanitize the most common points in our building prior to and following each service.
- Hand sanitizer will be made available.
- Childcare will not be provided and we will not have Children's Church.
- Connection Groups (Sunday School) will not be meeting in the church building and continue to meet online.
- Ushers will escort our members and guests to their seats to maintain the required social distancing. Families may sit together without spacing
- When the service is over, ushers will dismiss the congregation by rows to ensure social distancing. Please do not congregate in the foyer or parking lot.
- We will not "pass the plate" for the offering. Giving stations will be made available.
- Please no handshaking or hugging!
- If you are not feeling well or have recently been ill (within the past 14 days), please stay home and worship online.
- The Corner Café will continue to be closed and no food or drink will be allowed.
- STBC Volunteers will be wearing masks and we strongly encourage others to do the same. This will be a different experience from what we're used to, but even in this limited capacity, it will be good to see each other again.
