Different forms of what we call “The Golden Rule” have been around for a long, long time. In Ancient Egypt it was taught “that which you hate to be done to you do not do to another.” In Ancient Greece you have teachings such as “avoid doing what you would blame others for doing,” and “do not do to others what angers you when they do it to you.” Even the Romans taught “treat your inferior as you wish your superior treat you.” Notice almost all of these teachings come at this idea from a negative perspective. Something like: if you don’t like it, don’t do it to someone else...”

But in the Old Testament we see God’s teaching goes beyond not doing to others what you don’t want them to do to you and enters the realm of positive action. In Leviticus 19:18 the Lord admonishes His people to “...love your neighbor as you love yourself.” Jesus gave the definitive answer to all human relations when he said: “So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the law and the prophets.” Wow! Did you catch that? When we actively treat others as we want to be treated, we fulfill the totality of the law and the prophets!

I wonder if sometimes we are more like the Egyptians, Grecians, and Romans in that we passively practice this rule by not doing what we would not want done to us? As believers we are called to go beyond that. Let’s honor our Lord by doing what He’s asked us to do!

STBC Re-opening Guidelines

- The church will sanitize the most common points in our building prior to and following each service.
- Hand sanitizer will be made available.
- Childcare will not be provided and we will not have Children's Church.

- The Corner Café will continue to be closed and no food or drink will be allowed.
- **STBC volunteers, members and guests** will wear masks as you enter and exit the Worship Center per Dallas County Mask order. Once in your seat and social distanced, you may remove your mask. This will be a different experience from what we're used to, but even in this limited capacity, it will be good to see each other again.
