#### **Pastor Search Committee Timeline**

#### November 10th through November 17th:

Receive nominations for Pastor Search Committee

- Each church member may nominate up to five (5) members.
- The nomination form must be signed by the member.
- The twenty (20) nominees with the greatest number of nominations will be placed on the ballot.
- The Personnel Committee will have the responsibility to ensure the 20 nominees are willing to serve.

#### December 8th: Vote for Pastor Search Committee

- Each church member may vote for up to seven (7) members.
- The ballot must be signed by the member.
- The seven (7) people receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected to the Committee. The next two (2) people receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected alternates.
- The Pastor Search Committee shall elect its own chairperson.

**December 15:** The Pastor Search Committee will be announced.
