Part 4: What is God's plan for my life?
Matthew 7:7-8

Step #1: Ask

⁷"Ask and it will be given to you ⁸For everyone who asks receives" Matthew 7:7-8

- **Rate where you are:** in your journal, on a scale from 1-10, with 1 being miserable and 10 being outstanding, rate how you feel you're doing in each of the following categories: emotionally, physically, financially, spiritually, socially, professionally, and relationally.
- **Imagine your desired future:** What will my relationships be like (family, social, professional)? What will my finances look like (how much would I like to be able to give away)? What will my overall emotional patterns look like (master or slave; positive or negative)? How will I handle adversity? How will I constantly be growing? How will I be looking more like Jesus, and what will I do to get there?

Step #2: Seek

⁷" ... seek and you will find" Matthew 7:7

knowledge + experience + service = wisdom

Knowledge: through books, classes, **graduating** but never stop learning!

Experience: through your own successes and failures; and that of others ("The way of fools seems right to them, but the wise listen to advice" Proverbs 12:15).

Service: because "it is more blessed to **give** than to receive" (Acts 20:35)

Step #3: Knock

⁷"... knock and the door will be opened to you." Matthew 7:7

- What if you could have both the **Guidebook** and a personal **Guide**? You can! But you have to ask, seek, and knock to open the door to Jesus.
