# Step #1: Ask

<sup>7</sup>"Ask and it will be given to you ... . <sup>8</sup>For everyone who asks receives ... ." Matthew 7:7-8

- Rate where you are: in your journal, on a scale from 1-10, with 1 being miserable and 10 being outstanding, rate how you feel you're doing in each of the following categories: emotionally, physically, financially, spiritually, socially, professionally, and relationally.
- Imagine your desired future: What will my relationships be like (family, social, professional)? What will my finances look like (how much would I like to be able to give away)? What will my overall emotional patterns look like (master or slave; positive or negative)? How will I handle adversity? How will I constantly be growing? How will I be looking more like Jesus, and what will I do to get there?
