Why Are We Here? Part 1: To Love God Matthew 22:34-40

What is required to love God?

1. A Feeling: "with all your heart"

> Before we can experience a love for God, we must first try to grasp His love for us.

Exodus 34:6-7, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin." (see also Deut. 10:12; Psalm 32:10; Jer. 31:3; John 3:16; Rom. 5:8; Rev. 1:5-6)

1 John 4:9-10, 19 ⁹This is how God showed his <u>love</u> among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. ¹⁰This is <u>love</u>: not that we <u>loved</u> God, but that he <u>loved</u> us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. ... ¹⁹ We <u>love</u> because he first loved us.

2. A Filling: "with all your soul"

Romans 5:5, God has poured out his <u>love</u> into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us.

> Yielding our lives to the control of the Holy Spirit and being filled by Him empowers and equips us to express love for God and others. This is accomplished through worship.

3. A Following: "with all your mind"

John 14:23-24, ²³ Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. ²⁴ Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching."
